AN ANTONINE HISTORY

SAINT VINAGE ...
TO THE CHÂTEAU DES ANTONINS

The Chateau des Antonins owes its name to the monks who occupied this old abbey for five centuries. These Antonins' monks acquired their reputation throughout Europe by treating patients suffering from ergotism (epidemic of infected rye), also called St. Anthony fire or Ardent.

The Antonins healed their patients through the administration of healthier food, the famous pig of St Anthony, but the monks also had the secrets of a drink with extraordinary therapeutic virtues: The Saint Vinage, a miraculous drink with a base of wine and aromatic plants.

On the Vézelay shrine route, the Antonins commandery still offers a comforting stopover for pilgrims to Santiago de Compostela. This beautiful architectural ensemble, well preserved and full of charm, is listed in the inventory of historic monuments.

MEN

In 1985, Geoffroy and Martine de Roquefeuil settled on the family property and revived the wine and hospitality tradition of the Antonins monks. With a soul of a countryman and a winemaker, Geoffroy recreates with passion and ardor, the vineyard and cellars. Lover of nature and concerned about preserving it, animated by a tenacious peasant common sense, he tirelessly seeks the best expression of his terroir to produce tasty wines with character.

In 2014, after studying agricultural engineering at Purpan, Antoine spent a year on the family estate. Then he went for 15 months in New Zealand to enrich his experience. In 2016, he decides to take over the Château des Antonins, following his father. He now, takes care of the wine production.

In 2019, Daniel Castaing joined the Antonins's team and helps in managing the vineyard.

A VINEYARD

The Château des Antonins takes root on the left bank of the Garonne, at the gates of Graves and Sauternes. The vineyard covers 25 hectares of red vines (65% Merlot, 33% Cabernet Sauvignon, 2% Cabernet Franc) on a silico-gravelly rump and 5 hectares of White vines (80% Sauvignon, 20% Semillon) on sandy loam soil. The management of the vineyard is part of an environmental approach for a thoughtful and sustainable agriculture. The entire estate has obtained High Environmental Value Level 3 (HVE3) certification since the 2018 harvest.

Honest, fruity and structured wines, available in 3 colors. All the wines are blended wines whose proportions vary according to the cuvées and the vintages.
