History:

This wine owes its name to the Antonin's hospitaller monks who occupied this old abbey for five centuries. Since 2016, Antoine de Roquefeuil is in charge of the estate's wine production, following his father, Geoffroy de Roquefeuil

Wine:

Terroir: sandy loam soil, located on the left bank of the Garonne, south of the Graves

Grape varieties: 100% Cabernet Sauvignon

Vineyard management: Reasoned, certified High Environmental Value, level 3*

Aging: in stainless steel vats

Vinification: Direct pressing for Cabernet Sauvignon and for Merlot. Alcoholic fermentation controlled at low temperature.

Bottled: February 2025

Production: 8,500 bottles

Alcohol by volume: 12.5%

Comments: Peach-colored. The nose seduces with its elegance and a revelation of rose's scent, English candy, red fruit coulis. The delight continues on the palate with a nice balance, roundness on the attack and final freshness.
